## **PROLOGUE**

#### YESTERDAY:

#### LET ME TELL YOU A STORY...

On February 24, 2022, the Russian Army invaded Ukraine in a major escalation of the ongoing, undeclared war between the two countries that began in 2014. Assured of easy victory by his intelligence services, Russian President Vladimir Putin was so confident that he had his frontline troops pack dress uniforms to wear in the victory parade following the inevitable fall of Kyiv.

Volodymyr Zelensky, the recently elected president of Ukraine, was expected to flee the invading Russian forces moving at blitz-krieg speed toward Kyiv. Zelensky had assumed control of an entirely corrupt government torn apart by various internal factions, and he was woefully unprepared to lead a nation in war with his background as a former comedian and actor.

The invasion, however, did not go as planned for Putin's military. Ukrainians turned to guerilla warfare and bedeviled the advancing Russian columns. Massive internal inefficiencies and failures within the Russian forces bogged down the attack.

Zelensky also surprised Putin by refusing to flee. He used his media skills to mobilize the world through social media and video production to release a series of inspirational and effective statements to rally his own people and the Western world to Ukraine's support.

Days turned into weeks, and weeks turned into months. Military equipment and humanitarian aid flowed into Ukraine. The resources were enough to keep Ukraine standing, though not enough to make significant advances against Putin's invading forces.

Russian losses in soldiers and equipment mounted, and Putin began to face serious consequences as the weakness of his army was exposed before the world.

#### THE WEST RESPONDS

Finland and Sweden voted to join NATO soon after Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Zelensky pushed for his nation to join the European Union. Russia's military plans began to unravel as the West continued to pour money, machinery, technical advice, intelligence, and other resources to support Ukraine's military and offer humanitarian assistance.

Russia refused to fall back, instead sending huge infantry forces through the former Soviet republic's mud and snow while massive artillery bombardments struck from a distance.

Frustrated with his lack of progress, Putin mobilized 300,000 troops to bolster his ground forces in eastern Ukraine. Taken mostly from poor, isolated areas, his state security force's tactics in snatching young men randomly off the street and sending them

off to war remained largely unreported in Russian media.

Putin gave orders to pulverize Ukraine from the air, throwing every artillery shell, missile, and drone he could scrape together. Many of his weapons missed their intended targets, leading to a number of civilian casualties.

#### **RUSSIA'S HISTORY WITH UKRAINE**

Few Americans cared that Russia annexed Crimea in 2014, and even fewer knew it was part of Ukraine. Almost no one can name the towns where the war is being fought or could spell the names of locations like Bakhmut, Slovyansk, Lyman, or Kramatorsk.

Ukraine was known as Soviet Ukraine, a republic of the Soviet Union from 1922 until 1991. The republic gained independence in 1991 as the Soviet Union dissolved and declared itself neutral.

Ukraine was the third-largest nuclear power in the world and held about one-third of the former Soviet Union's nuclear weapons, delivery systems, and significant means of its design, knowledge, and production. However, the Budapest Memorandum, signed on December 5, 1994, resulted in a multilateral agreement affirming Ukraine's security and sovereignty in exchange for giving up the nuclear stocks.

The United States, under President Clinton, took credit for achieving it. The warheads were shipped intact to Russia, a procedure the United States insisted upon.

A new constitution was adopted in 1996. A series of mass demonstrations, known as the Euromaidan, led to establishing a new government in 2014 after a revolution.

Russia then unilaterally annexed Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula.

Pro-Russian unrest culminated in a war in the Donbas between Russian-backed separatists and government forces in eastern Ukraine. This ongoing regional conflict was the background of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine in February 2022.

#### **IRAN JOINS THE FIGHT**

Ukrainian officials watched nervously as Russia turned air-defense missiles into attack missiles and sent them into Ukraine *en masse*. Meanwhile, Iran mass-produced small, cheap, Shahed-136 attack drones that cost a mere \$20,000 apiece and sent them to Russia by the thousands.

The Iranian drones were difficult to knock out of the sky. The only effective countermeasure was to fire expensive American air-defense missiles provided in limited quantities to Ukraine. The estimated cost of knocking down each Iranian drone ran between \$140,000 and \$500,000 apiece. In addition, Ukraine is estimated to have lost more than 60 aircraft, and Russia more than 70 aircraft.

Belarus, closely tied to Russia, was happy to let Putin fire artillery attacks from inside its country, which was even closer to Kyiv than most military bases inside Russia. Belarus also provided a convenient staging ground for resupply operations and medevac trains.

The scale of destruction on the ground in Ukraine was difficult to comprehend as artillery attacks, numbering in the hundreds of shells or drones at a time, rained down on Ukraine daily.

Zelensky begged the West for the weaponry he needed to counter the incoming missiles, drones, and artillery barrages that steadily destroyed villages, towns, schools, hospitals, the water

supply, dams, and Ukraine's power grid. The West sent billions of dollars in supplies, but not enough for Ukraine to push Russia out of its territory.

It began to look like the West was content to fight a proxy war with Russia in Ukraine, using the Ukrainian army and its civilian population as cannon fodder. Russia appeared committed to fighting a long-term artillery battle in Ukraine despite Western opposition.

On March 14, 2023, the U.S. military confirmed that a Russian fighter jet collided with an American Reaper drone over the Black Sea, bringing the unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) down. The military said one of two Russian fighters clipped the drone's propeller, forcing the U.S. to bring it down in the area of intense NATO military activity close to the Ukraine war frontlines amid Russia's ongoing invasion of the country.

"Our MQ-9 aircraft was conducting routine operations in international airspace when it was intercepted and hit by a Russian aircraft, resulting in a crash and complete loss of the MQ-9," U.S. Air Force General James Hecker, who oversees the U.S. Air Force in the region, said in a statement.

#### THE RUSSIA-IRAN PROBLEM FACING ISRAEL

Russia and Iran grew closer and strengthened their political and ideological ties. The common interest included a desire for the demise of a democratic West with its decadent lifestyle, corrupt political systems, and morally bankrupt societies.

What had been a relatively loose alliance in the past between Russia and Iran grew much more serious. Russia began offering

Iran support similar to its backing of Syria in the early 2000s. In return for the drones and artillery shells Iran provided for Russia, Iran asked for the final pieces to complete its nuclear weapons development program to become a nuclear nation. Russia didn't immediately agree to provide this assistance but soon offered the needed resources to help.

### TODAY:

#### THE NUCLEAR QUESTION

Putin also considered using a nuclear weapon in Ukraine. As the war stalled, he needed a dramatic move to force the Ukrainian people to surrender and bolster his flagging image as an invincible strongman.

American intelligence sources began to warn that Iran had already made more enriched uranium than it needed for its nuclear energy program. According to the latest intelligence, Iran was only a matter of weeks away from being able to produce the materials it would need to make a nuclear weapon.

Israeli leadership frantically considered how to defend itself against a nuclear Iran. None of the options were good ones. It was left pondering the least terrible outcomes of various possible responses to this existential threat. Worse, its warnings to the United States of a nuclear arms race in the Middle East fell on mostly deaf ears.

The U.S. president and a majority of Congress were fully

convinced Putin was a leader who needed to be defeated at any cost. They completely ignored the larger international implications of humiliating a cornered dictator with half the nuclear weapons of the world at his disposal.

Putin was a demon-possessed madman whose delusion was that he was the savior of Orthodox Christianity and civilization. He believed that Russia's mortality and his own were one and the same. The head of the Orthodox Church in Russia anointed Putin as the "chief exorcist" to bring about the de-Satanifcation of Ukraine and America, the Great Satan.

#### **PUTIN'S MOVE**

As much as the Americans would've loved to see him go away—either from rumored illness or from a coup d'état inside the Russian government—neither happened. Putin was not on death's door as it was optimistically rumored, and furthermore, he was firmly in control of his government and his country. In fact, he held all of Russia in an iron fist.

Putin made it clear he was prepared to wait for recession and famine to settle in across the world. Going into the war in early 2023, grain reserves stored around the world were tapped to feed many nations as Ukraine missed most of its growing season that year and Russia chose to hoard grain at home.

In addition, the price of oil continued to be volatile. After the European Union imposed a price cap on what it was willing to pay for Russian oil (enough to pay for production but not enough to give any leftover profit to Putin to pay for his war), Putin cut off all oil shipments to Europe.

As Putin ran low on artillery shells, weapons, and ammunition, he increasingly turned to Iran to provide him with the equipment he needed to continue his relentless attack on Ukraine. Iran was happy to oblige. The larger the debt Putin owed them, the less able he would be to turn down the payment they asked for in return. Iran's Supreme leader, Ali Khamenei, another demon-possessed madman, and Putin were a marriage made in hell. Khamenei, a Twelver Shia believer, was convinced an apocalypse would usher in the Mahdi—the Islamic messiah.

As the one-year anniversary of the war approached, Zelensky was invited to speak to the United States Congress and made a press junket across Europe, rallying his allies to continue pouring aid into Ukraine. The United States and other Western nations proudly vowed to continue supporting Ukraine to the bitter end and never to abandon their ally. The U.S. has provided \$113 billion so far.

The Russian Orthodox Church originated in Kyiv. The country had been considered Orthodox since 988 when the bishops of Constantinople baptized the land, which was then ruled by the Kievan Rus. In 2022, cathedrals and monasteries were searched by Ukrainian intelligence who reported that they eventually found evidence of collaboration between the bishops and priests and Russia's secret police.

In 2023, Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelensky began stripping priests of the country of citizenship beginning in Kyiv. Ukrainians usually celebrate Christmas on January 7, as do the Russians, but the date was changed to celebrate it on December 25 in Ukraine to move Ukrainian churches away from their alliance with the Russian Orthodox Church in light of the Archbishop of the

Russian Orthodox Church Patriarch Kirill giving Vladimir Putin his blessing for the denazification of Ukraine and Putin proclaiming him the chief exorcist.

Russia has also increased its connections with China. President Xi Jinping of China met with Putin on March 20, 2023, to strengthen bilateral relations, regardless of the continued fighting in Ukraine. Xi made it clear that he remained committed to building a strong relationship with Russia as an invaluable partner in countering American global influence.

"Consolidating and developing Chinese-Russian relations is a strategic choice that China has made in the light of its own fundamental interests and the broad trends of global development," Xi said.

The meeting provided a giant morale boost and a chance to showcase the much-vaunted new world order that the Russian leader believes he is forging through his war on Ukraine in which the U.S. and NATO can no longer dictate anything to anyone. Xi's visit to Russia brought together two leaders who have positioned themselves for life, setting a scene for global confrontation. China is increasingly willing to use its partnership with Moscow to counter Washington, even if that means granting approval to Putin's brutal, destabilizing war.

#### **ISRAEL'S RESPONSE**

Notably absent from that group of nations flooding military aid into Ukraine was Israel. Not many people thought to ask why Israel was not uniting in potential World War III against Russia, particularly while Putin claimed to be de-Nazifying Ukraine, which was led by a

Jewish president. Israel gave massive humanitarian aid to Ukraine and also opened its nation to over 15,000 Ukrainian refugees, along with much more done covertly.

But Israel realized a pogrom could easily happen in Russia, making life a living hell for its Jewish population. Russia also controlled the airspace in Syria and could shut the skies down at any time, keeping Israel from flying missions to attack Iran's arms shipments going into Lebanon. Iran had already shipped 250,000 missiles into Lebanon. Most importantly, Israel feared that the Russia-Ukraine war going badly for Putin could force him to grant Iran its atomic ambitions in exchange for missiles and drones and to also open another front complicating the West's ability in Ukraine.

#### THE FUTURE:

#### THE WEST CONTINUES SUPPORTING UKRAINE

The West had a limited supply of high-tech, expensive air defense missiles to give to Ukraine. That disparity took its toll, and over time, the Ukrainians were unable to stop the ongoing barrage of artillery attacks. The Ukrainian people on the ground were left to hide in bomb shelters and carry on with life in an increasingly ruined landscape with little to no surviving infrastructure. Running water, flushing toilets, electricity, cell phone towers—they all became luxuries that few had access to.

Some 15 million Ukrainians were displaced by the end of 2023, and that number—and the flood of refugees into Europe—only

continued to grow. The strain on European economies was immense and contributed to recessions and shortages across the Western world as 2024 advanced.

Meanwhile, the civilian death toll in Ukraine continued to climb alarmingly. Over 100,000 Ukrainian soldiers were either killed or wounded on the battlefield while many more civilians died as a result of the incessant shelling, war crimes by the Russian army, and the privations and lack of medical care available on the ground. The entire nation of Ukraine was suffering from post-traumatic stress after a nine-and-a-half-year war with no end in sight.

The West was forced to send massive military weapons to Ukraine to compensate for the exhaustion of its increasingly outnumbered and beleaguered Ukrainian army forces.

Although Russia's forces vastly outnumbered Ukraine's, the West still had weapons and technology superior enough to Russia's to keep Ukraine in the fight. As long as Ukraine continued to have warm bodies to operate the West's excellent military equipment, it could continue to fight on. Ukrainians were making astonishing sacrifices and were astonishingly brave. As long as they were willing to keep fighting, the West was willing to keep arming them.

Putin was able to sit back and continue to lob artillery shells without end at Ukraine, not putting much of his army at risk and managing to keep the Ukrainians pretty much on their heels as he finished, literally, leveling Ukraine. In his mind, time was his friend and the West's enemy. He was able to defeat the West in Syria by fighting a war in its twelfth year with the support of Iran, thanks to

General Qasem Soleimani, who forged an Iranian-Russian alliance in support of President Assad.

The pressure on the West began to build. They were going to have to send not only the best of their weapons, and a lot of them, but tanks and planes to prevent Ukraine from losing.

Europe had stockpiled enough heating oil to get through the winter of 2023, but it did not have sufficient reserves left to see it through the winter of 2024. Putin's long-game strategy of using food and oil and refugees as weapons finally began to bite. Recession, fuel and energy shortages, and famine struck on a global scale. More people in Africa died from famine because of food shortages in Ukraine than had died in the war with Russia.

#### WAR FATIGUE SETS IN

Fatigue for the war built in the West. There wasn't enough food to go around, prices were skyrocketing, fuel was scarce, and people began to ask if it was worth it just to keep a completely destroyed Ukraine drawn on the map. Plus, a U.S. presidential election was taking place, and the election became a referendum on Ukraine. America was disgusted over the last two wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. The humiliation of the U.S. withdrawal in Afghanistan, in addition to the outcry that we needed to protect our border, not Ukraine's, pressured candidates into promising to stop supporting Ukraine if elected. With over \$100 billion of taxpayer dollars given to the most corrupt country in Europe, it was not sitting well with U.S. taxpayers.

Protecting Ukraine is not a "vital" national interest for the U.S. While the U.S. has many vital national interests—securing

our borders, addressing the crisis of readiness within our military, achieving energy security and independence, and checking the economic, cultural, and military power of the Chinese Communist Party—becoming further entangled in a territorial dispute between Ukraine and Russia is not one of them, according to some conservatives.

Republicans said that the administration did not have a clear policy objective and a clear goal except to drag things out in Ukraine and that the U.S. was giving Ukraine just enough to survive but not to win. If we will not give Ukraine the weapons to win the war, why are we giving them the weapons to fight one?

Research done by a Washington think tank was being used by the anti-Ukraine faction of the Republican Party. It said the slow pace of U.S. production means it will take us as much as 15 years at peacetime production levels and more than eight years at wartime tempo to replace the stocks of major weapons systems such as guided missiles and drones if they were destroyed in battle or donated to Ukraine.

#### RUSSIA'S DESPERATION

Russia also paid a heavy price for continuing the war. The inefficiencies and corruption of its army meant that thousands of Russian soldiers died or were seriously injured. Hundreds of thousands more men fled Russia to avoid the draft, and as the war dragged on, those refugee men began to settle abroad and give up on ever returning home to Russia.

Russia considered the loss in Afghanistan a key reason for the collapse of the U.S.S.R. Tens of thousands of dead soldiers were

never acknowledged—they were simply called black tulips—an omission that offended the Russian population and helped lead to the fall of the Soviet Union. The Soviet Army lost hundreds of aircraft, and two million Afghan men, women, and children died in the war.

Plus, Putin knew that the U.S.-funded Islamic Jihadists spent billions in arms to defeat the Russians in Afghanistan while at the same time, the U.S. was orchestrating a massive arms race along with pushing the price of oil down, which would ultimately bankrupt the Soviet Union. Ronald Regan did more than say, "Tear down this wall." He actually tore it down.

Putin believed his battle was a war between the West and Russia—World War III—and that America's goal was to wipe Russia off the map as it did the U.S.S.R.

The Russian economy reverted to the most basic production—food, fuel, and materials for war. Quality of life in Russia plummeted. Although there was deep discontent among the population, the complete control exerted by Putin through his massive State Security Force held, and he maintained an iron grip on everyone and everything.

However, Russian military generals and high-ranking government officials began to pressure Putin to stand up to America with its greatest weapons. They needed a decisive victory sooner rather than later if Russia was to emerge from the war with any capacity to rebuild itself into a global power. Frankly, all it had left that qualified it for that title were half the world's nuclear weapons. By every other measure, Russia had slipped out of world power status months ago.

#### **IRAN'S NUCLEAR AMBITIONS FULFILLED**

Meanwhile, Iran was feeling pressures of its own. Starting in the fall of 2022, widespread protests were taking place across Iran in response to excessive police brutality in the murder of a young woman, Mahsa Amini, arrested for the simple crime of showing too much hair.

The Russians sent security specialists to Iran to teach the Iranian government how to suppress dissent and control the population more effectively. As a result, sports figures, celebrities, and outspoken activists were arrested by the hundreds, and some of them were very publicly executed in an effective campaign to terrorize the population into settling down.

The majority of regular Iranian people did not support their religiously controlled government's extreme stance nor its fanatical belief in the coming of a Mahdi—a messianic figure who would come at the end times to usher in a golden age of Islam just before the end of the world. But there was nothing they could do about it since the Mullahs ran the country.

The Iranian regime, bolstered by support from Putin, refused to continue negotiating for any sort of return to the JCPOA, the Iran Nuclear Arms Deal of 2015, that prohibited it from developing nuclear weapons, and which the U.S. withdrew from in 2018, ultimately collapsing it.

Iran already had enough enriched uranium stockpiled to create at least a dozen nuclear bombs. It ordered its 4,000 accelerated advanced centrifuges—nearly double the number it had at the beginning of the Ukraine-Russia War—to spin up to maximum capacity. Working to produce enriched uranium in the shortest

amount of time, it fed uranium enriched up to 60% U-235 into all the cascades at its fuel enrichment plant.

It took Iran less than one week to accomplish the necessary enrichment work for each bomb it planned to build. For each week Ukraine survived and the Russia-Ukraine war dragged on, propped up entirely by the West at this point, Iran made enough weaponsgrade uranium for another nuclear weapon.

Israel waited and watched nervously as Russia began to discuss more openly the idea of providing Iran with the resources to not only build nuclear weapons but provide the missiles to deliver them. In the spring of 2023, a deal was reached between Russia and Iran to buy SU-35 and F-35 fighter jets.

U.S. intelligence leaked a secret deal between the Chinese and Saudi Arabia in which the Chinese negotiated a peace deal between Iran and Saudi Arabia in exchange for China guaranteeing Saudi Arabia a nuclear reactor if evidence proved Iran was going nuclear.

In recent years, China has helped Saudi Arabia build its own ballistic missiles, consulted on a nuclear program, and begun investing in Prince Mohammed's projects, such as Neom, a futuristic new city. China has also pitched to Saudi officials on setting up a local defense-manufacturing industry, while Russia has signed a nuclear cooperation deal with the kingdom. China also began to sell Russia its Mugin-5 drones, manufactured by Mugin Limited, a Chinese company based in Xiamen, on the east coast of China.

Why does China support Russia's war in Ukraine? Because it weakens America's military arsenal. If a nuclear war happened between Russia and the European Union with the U.S., China would be the only one standing and would rule the world.

#### THE POINT OF NO RETURN

The President called for a meeting with America's leading military contractors, dubbed "The Last Supper." The purpose of the meeting was to inform them of the massive weaponry that the U.S. would require, the looming threat of a Chinese invasion of Taiwan, and the need to prepare for a potential war with China.

During the meeting, The Last Supper group informed the president that in the event of a large-scale war with China, the United States would run out of long-range anti-ship missiles within a week. They explained that due to the depletion of resources during the Ukraine war, key components such as artillery shells, missiles, air defense systems, counter artillery radar, Javelin missiles, SM-6 missiles, unmanned aerial vehicles, cruise missiles, Stinger anti-aircraft missiles, and ball bearings were all exhausted.

As an example, the United States has given up over one-third of its Javelin missile inventory to Ukraine. Surprisingly, one arms package included 1,000 Javelin missiles despite the low inventory. The current production rate is about 1,000 per year.

The group further clarified that the U.S. had given 7,500 HIMAR launchers to Ukraine in the first year and 10,000 in the second year, leaving the U.S. in no position to provide Taiwan with the necessary weaponry or even defend the country adequately. The group concluded that under no circumstances would the U.S. be able to defeat China if a large-scale war broke out over the Taiwan crisis, due to the depletion of U.S. firearms and resources in Ukraine.

Then American intelligence sources confirmed a sighting made by the Mossad, that the crates of equipment and parts had been

loaded on a cargo ship in the Russian port of Astrakhan, where the mighty Volga River empties into the Caspian Sea and the site of Russia's largest Caspian Sea port.

The ship set sail across the Caspian Sea bound for the port of Anzali, Iran's largest Caspian Sea port. The crossing would take four, maybe five, days. When that ship arrived, the time it would take for Iran to become a nuclear power would go from weeks to days. Russia possessed a total of 5,977 nuclear warheads, the largest stockpile in the world, along with the world's largest arsenal of ballistic missiles. All of Iran's dreams were about to come true.

And then Putin dropped a low-yield nuclear weapon on Zelensky's hometown, Kryvyi Rih, in south-central Ukraine. It was a warning shot across the bow to Zelensky and the West that Putin was prepared to do whatever it took to win the war. At all costs.

The world, while horrified, was not prepared to launch retaliatory nuclear strikes against Russia and risk provoking the end of the world with a free-for-all nuclear exchange between Russia and the West.

In light of the seriousness of the attack and thermal radiation winds, the nuclear attack provoked an instant response from NATO announcing that Article 5 had been invoked. Article 5 says that an attack on one is an attack on all NATO members.

The U.S. president was informed that a nuclear war between the United States and Russia would plunge the Earth into a nuclear winter within days due to the level of smoke and soot released into the atmosphere which would ultimately mean the death of onethird of humanity.

- <sup>15</sup> And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind....
- <sup>18</sup> A third of mankind was killed by the three plagues of fire, smoke and sulfur that came out of their mouths (Revelation 9:15, 18).

China, calculating that a window of opportunity was available to invade Taiwan, launched a massive, conventional preemptive strike on the island nation and seized it almost overnight. The Chinese watched and waited until the U.S. weapon supply was dangerously low.

Iran announced that it was a nuclear state, and all the Sunni, oil-rich nations in the Gulf region announced an urgent nuclear arms race of their own. In just a few years, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, and the United Arab Emirates would obtain nuclear arsenals of their own as enemies of Iran. Only the Persian Gulf would separate them—a less than one-hour missile flight.

#### THE SAMSON OPTION

Israel realized that Russia had acquiesced to Iran's insistent requests for nuclear weaponization help. Russia decided to not only share information and technicians on how to build a miniaturized nuclear warhead that would fit on an IRBM—an

intermediate-range ballistic missile—but it also shared information, tools, and technical instruction on how to build MRVs—multiple re-entry vehicles, where up to three warheads with three separate targets could be mounted on a single ballistic missile delivery system.

In the days before the 1967 Six-Day War, Israel planned to insert a team of paratroopers by helicopter into the Sinai. Their mission was to set up and remotely detonate a nuclear bomb on a mountaintop as a warning to belligerent surrounding states. The greatly outnumbered Jewish state in a surprising turn of events effectively eliminated the Egyptian Air Force and occupied the Sinai, winning the war before the test could even be set up. Retired Israeli brigadier General Itzhak Yaakov referred to this operation as the Israeli Samson Option.

In the 1973 Yom Kippur War, Arab forces were overwhelming Israeli forces and Prime Minister Golda Meir authorized a nuclear alert and ordered 13 atomic bombs be readied for use by missiles and aircraft. The Israeli Ambassador warned President Nixon of "very serious conclusions" if the United States did not airlift supplies. Nixon complied. This is seen by some commentators on the subject as the first threat of the use of the Samson Option.

Iran realized that with the introduction of missiles in silos on Iranian soil and the completion of its nuclear development program, it was opening itself up to a preemptive strike of some kind from Israel. It would not be enough for Iran simply to have nuclear weapons. It would also need some sort of umbrella of protection for itself. And Russia could also provide that protective umbrella over Iranian airspace.

Israel has for many years had one of the best-equipped and best-trained air forces in the world. Iran could never hope to match Israel in either quality or quantity of airplanes, top-notch pilots, or air defense systems. But with Russia's help, it didn't have to if it went atomic and had Russian planes controlling its airspace.

If Russia was willing to put its own airplanes in the skies over Iran, both Russia and Iran could dare Israel to shoot those planes down and risk massive retaliation. It wouldn't even have to be nuclear retaliation. Israel realized Iran would momentarily be protected by a nuclear umbrella, as it were. Possession of nuclear weapons would protect Iran from any future attacks against it.

#### **IRAN'S OPERATION MAHDI**

Iran, not satisfied to destroy the Little Satan, Israel, decided to position itself to attack the Great Satan, the United States, as well.

Iran launched Operation Mahdi, and hundreds of lead-lined containers were shipped, filled with chemical and biological weapons through LCL (less than container load). When cargo shipped by sea is not enough to fill a container, buyers often opt to share container space with other shippers, but for Iran, the plan was to ship in from 26 countries so the U.S. could not detect them. They were all lead-lined, being shipped to major U.S. cities to be detonated in simultaneous attacks.

One hundred jihadist suicide bombers carried backpacks weighing 80-100 pounds. In them were suitcase nuclear bombs. Each bomb had a charge of one kiloton equivalent to one thousand tons of TNT. One device in Washington, D.C., would destroy everything within a half-mile of the capital. Within hours the prevailing

winds would carry the nuclear fallout throughout Washington. The Nuclear Threat Initiative (NTI) published a report in September 1997 that quoted the Russian national security advisor Alexander Lebed who claimed that the Russian military lost track of upwards of 100 nuclear suitcase bombs.

These sleeper cells, made up of kamikaze Iranian Revolutionary Guards, were given instructions to attack the government, culture, and unsuspecting citizens, cause mayhem, and destroy the United States from within.

For decades before and after the fall of Iraq, Iran funded and infiltrated Shiite assets all over the Middle East, ready and waiting for the order to attack America the great Satan and Israel the little Satan from inside and from without. Iran attacked Israel through its proxies: Hamas, Islamic Jihad, the Mahdi army, Hezbollah, and others.

Although Israel's air defense system, Iron Dome, was able to stop about 90% of incoming rockets or missiles, there came a point when sheer numbers of incoming projectiles would overwhelm the system. Israel urgently worked to upgrade its Iron Dome Defense system with Iron Beam, a directed energy fiber laser system to knock down airborne targets, but it would take time to operationally deploy the system.

Aware that quantity was the only way to overwhelm the quality of the Israeli air defense system, Hezbollah, an Iranian proxy in Lebanon, stocked up on as many as 300,000 Iranian rockets and small missiles which Iran was delighted to provide. Syria, another Iranian proxy, launched its planes with bombs with zero warning time toward Israel.

#### **ISRAEL STARES AT AN APOCALYPSE**

Israel was staring an apocalypse in the face—a nuclear Iran with its skies aggressively protected by Russia under a nuclear umbrella was on the horizon.

Israel, which had excellent intelligence assets throughout the Gulf region, caught wind of the Iranians' preparations for war. The 24 SU-35 Flanker fighter jets that Iran purchased from Russia when the U.S. blocked their sale to Egypt were delivered, along with the 60 fully operational Iranian pilots the Russians had trained. While the Israeli Air Force could make short work of the SU-35s and their inexperienced pilots, doing so would undoubtedly provoke Russia.

Israel faced a stark choice. On the one hand, Iran was nuclear and an atomic arms race in the Middle East had begun. A nuclear strike on Israel would allow religious leaders in Iran to create an apocalypse that they believed would usher in their messiah. Furthermore, the Iranians' religious beliefs stated that the Islamic Armageddon would include the destruction of Israel.

On the other hand, Israel could not risk a preemptive strike against Iran failing. If Israel, a tiny nation the size of New Jersey, took a retaliatory strike from Iran, it would be wiped out with a single nuclear weapon. If a preemptive Israeli strike wasn't 100% successful, it had no guarantee that Iran would not be able to hit Israel with an atomic bomb.

Israel's only option for surviving was to wipe out Iran and its plan for an apocalypse that would summon the Islamic messiah the Mahdi.

The only way to eradicate Iran's obsession would be the Samson

Option, Israel's deterrence strategy of massive retaliation with nuclear weapons before Russian planes began protecting Iranian airspace. The name is a reference to the biblical Israelite, Samson, who pushed down the pillars of the Philistine temple to destroy his enemies.

Sixteen to twenty million people would die in the initial nuclear strikes. Millions more could be expected to die slower, agonizing deaths by radiation poisoning afterward. Given the level of radiation that would come from a modern, high-yield, all-out nuclear strike, very few medical personnel and aid from other nations would be able to enter Iran to provide humanitarian assistance.

It was a terrible thing to contemplate, and Israel's senior leadership prayed fervently for some other alternative to present itself.

The doomsday clock was now seven seconds to midnight. God created the world in seven days. Either Iran's world would end in seven days or Israel's.

Israel's time to make a decision was up. It was now or never to take action to save itself. Eighty nuclear warheads would be launched, the Israeli Air Force planes were in the skies, F-151 and F-161s with atomic bombs along with Jericho 2 and 3 ballistic missiles along with submarine-launched nuclear-capable cruise missiles.

The End Times had arrived, and the final countdown to Armageddon had begun...

# **AUTHOR'S NOTE:**

**THE PERIOD OF TIME** we may be staring in the face is a 2,500-year-old prophecy by a prophet found in Ezekiel 38. It speaks of Rosh which is a shortened version of Russia. Ezekiel and Daniel both describe the end times using the phrase "king of the north" to describe the commander of an alliance in that time (Daniel 11:5-35; Ezekiel 38:6, 15). Russia is the only modern nation to match this description. Persia, modern Iran, is also mentioned in Ezekiel with regard to the End Times and about 35 more times in Scripture.

This Russia-Ukraine war is leading to astonishing alliances between Russia and Iran. This unlikely and unholy alliance would not have been possible were it not for the seismic events set in motion by Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

In Revelation 16:12-16, it describes a battle called Armageddon. It says:

"The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up to prepare the way for the kings from the East...demonic spirits that performed signs....go out to the kings

of the whole world to gather them for battle on the great day of God Almighty... then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon."

There is no doubt in my mind that if the Russia-Ukraine war goes on for an extended period, Russia will ultimately grant Iran's atomic ambitions with Russian planes protecting Iran's airspace. This will inevitably usher in a Gulf States nuclear arms race.

I was told by the former head of Israel's atomic energy commission that if a Middle East arms race happens, "We will have Armageddon in a decade."

The Ukrainians are beautiful people who are only trying to defend themselves. They've gone through a living hell. Through my son's leadership, my ministry delivered 8 million pounds of food in the first year of the war to the frontlines of the Jewish community and to churches filled with refugees.

It is my prayer that what I am writing about in this fictional scenario does not come to pass. But one thing is for certain: some of it will if the West refuses to give Ukraine the needed weapons to win the war. Also, prayer changes things. It is my prayer that believers will pray hard concerning these prophetic warnings.

This book is a prophetic wake-up call for all of us.

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## PREFACE

I HAD A DREAM. IN THE DREAM, I was at a four-way stoplight. I noticed all the lights were green and yet no one seemed to be alarmed.

I thought, "This is horrible. It's going to be a massive tragedy."

Then I looked to one of the corners of the street to cry out, and I saw people celebrating idols, drinking champagne, and partying. It was a huge political party celebrating their candidate. On the other corner, I saw more idols and a huge crowd and an auctioneer auctioning off stuff, boats, cars, vacation packages, and homes, and I saw more idolatry. Then I looked on the third corner and it was unspeakable immorality and idolatry.

Then I looked on the fourth corner and it was religious people. They had on religious robes but they were all worshipping idols and there were stones in their hands. They were circling someone. And when I looked at the center of the circle, I saw the person in the center was Jesus.

Suddenly out of nowhere, a cloud appeared with the words on it "final warning."

But nobody was alarmed. They wouldn't even look up.

Then all the green lights turn red. And when they turned red, there was something inside of each light. It was a hammer and a sickle. The hammer and the sickle touched each other. And when they did, the lights ignited and huge mushroom clouds started coming up from the red lights.

When I woke up, I started praying about the interpretation of the dream, and the interpretation came. I remembered the former head of the Israel Atomic Energy Commission telling me that if a nuclear arms race begins among the Gulf states, in ten years the world would experience Armageddon.

I have been going to Ukraine for over a decade, bringing food to impoverished Holocaust survivors and Jewish orphans. When the Ukraine-Russia war broke out in 2022, we ramped up our operation. On my first trip in after the war began, I was stuck at the border between Poland and Ukraine for many hours because of miles and miles of camouflaged military trucks going into Ukraine.

I turned to my companion and said, "Viktor, World War III is being fought right now between the West and Russia with plausible deniability."

More than a quarter million Ukrainian and Russian soldiers were casualties in the first year of the war. The U.S. has provided billions of dollars in aid to Ukraine since the war began. As I'm writing to you, Ukrainians are in Oklahoma being trained to use Patriot missiles.

The Russian-Ukrainian war has been the deadliest in Europe since World War II. The war quickly became a proxy war between the U.S.-led West and Russia. The roots of the conflict extend back to the collapse and disillusionment of the Soviet Union in the early 1990s.

I had lunch with Ronald Reagan shortly after he was elected and asked him what he was going to do about communism. He smiled and in his trademark whisper said, "Oh, I think I'll bankrupt it."

He did indeed. Russia has watched NATO steadily expand eastward, with most of the former USSR republics in eastern Europe joining NATO. The West has provided military assistance for Ukraine to continue waging war but not enough for Ukraine to win the war. The West continues to bleed Russia's economy of men, machinery, and resources.

Russia knows this. Russia has been fighting in Syria now going on 12 years. The architect of this Russian-Syrian alliance was General Qasem Soleimani who was in charge of Iran's foreign military strategy. He traveled to Moscow to see President Vladimir Putin and ask him if Russia would save the Syrian regime. The Syrian patriarch also appealed to Putin, saying that he could be the savior of Christianity.

As Russia loses troops and massive amounts of weaponry in the war in Ukraine, Iran is returning the favor by giving Russia thousands of drones, along with the support of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard in Crimea to train Russians on how to use them. Soon, surface-to-surface and surface-to-air missiles will also start arriving in Russia from Iran.

Iran believes that Russia will return the favor by guaranteeing the Islamic terrorist state a nuclear umbrella. That umbrella would not only mean Iran going nuclear but that Russia would protect Iran from any attacks against it as Russia has done in Syria.

If this were to come to pass, it would precipitate a Sunni, Gulf State nuclear arms race that will result in Armageddon within a decade, exactly as the former chairman of the nuclear atomic commission of Israel told me it would.

Approximately 2,500 years ago, Ezekiel predicted specific events concerning Russia's future. He begins in Ezekiel 38 with a long list of nations that will attack Israel. The reference to Rosh in verse 2 is a shortened version of the word Russia. The Bible describes Russia as being far to the north. Both Ezekiel and Daniel describe Israel's end-time aggressors as the being from the North.

The use of the phrase "king of the north" to describe the commander of the lions, Daniel 11:5, 35 seems to refer to Russia as well. Ezekiel's prophecy lends support to Daniel's, indicating a very large army will arrive in Israel from the far north, Ezekiel 38:6, 15. Russia is the only nation that fits this description well.

One name on Ezekiel's list, Gog, is the name of a national leader. We find this in Ezekiel 38:1-2. Second, Persia is mentioned in Ezekiel 38:5 and about 35 more times in Scripture. In 1935, Persia changed his name to Iran. Then, in 1979 it became the Islamic Republic of Iran. Today, Russia is Iran's strong strongest ally and Israel's strongest enemy.

Israel has been ostracized by the Biden administration for not

sending weapons into Ukraine, but Israel knows what I am telling you, that the Ukraine war will ultimately release an atomic Islamic State with a nuclear umbrella that is hell-bent on ushering in the 12<sup>th</sup> Imam.

Iranian religious leaders consider the 12th Imam, the Islamic Messiah, one who can only come after an apocalypse. The mullahs who run Iran believe a nuclear attack on the Little Satan, Israel, will usher in the Mahdi—the Islamic apocalypse—and the entire world will surrender and become Islamic.

That may sound totally nuts, but I've met with the former President of Iran, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad. He told me the exact same thing concerning the Mahdi and an apocalypse. What the mullahs believe is what the Iranian government's leaders—the people with the power to launch a nuclear strike—also believe.

Ahmadinejad told me that when he spoke to the U.N., nobody blinked for 26 to 28 minutes and that a green light filled the room. He also told me that Zionists lived to be 82 and Iranians 62 because Zionists send rats into Iran to poison its crops and people eat the poisoned food and die 20 years younger.

And these are the people on the verge of getting themselves a nuclear arsenal and protection from Russia for themselves and their nuclear weapons.

My son Michael is risking his life going to the frontlines of Ukraine, preaching the gospel, praying for the sick, and providing food to starving refugees. He has delivered more than 8 million pounds of food and supplies in twelve months. He and I have nothing but the deepest compassion and sympathy for the plight of the Ukrainian people.

The one person whom I believe has the ability to negotiate a resolution to this growing world war is Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Otherwise Israel, America, and the rest of the world will face our gravest national security threat ever.
